	Primary 2 pupils should be collected from Mrs Meehan's external door at 1.55pm.
	The Primary 1 day will end at 12.30pm up until Friday the 1 st October. From Tuesday the 5 th October Primary 1 pupils will finish at 1.55pm and exit via the external door in Mrs Meehan's room.
	To help with the smooth exit of pupils who walk or travel home by car in the evening we will continue the following arrangement; Surname A - L will exit via the pedestrian gate at

	Please keep entrance and the clearly marked bus area free until after both buses have departed. Buses depart school at 2.55pm.
