GAA Coaching:

Walking home from school:

Please find attached a consent form with regards to pupils walking home from school. This needs to be completed and returned to your child's teacher if your child is walking home from school on a regular basis.

If you wish your child/children to walk home occasionally then please write a note in homework diary, email child's teacher or telephone the school.

School Uniform:

It is important that each child comes to school neat and tidy. We are proud of our school uniform which reflects the individuality of our school and offers to all children a common form of dress.

Full school uniform must be worn each day unless special clothing is required e.g. for field trip.

PLEASE ENSURE ALL ITEMS OF UNIFORM ARE CLEARLY LABELLED.

Parents/Carers & pick up:

Primary 1 pupils enter the school each morning via the external door at Mrs Meehan's room. All other pupils enter via the main school entrance.

The buses will leave the school at 2.55pm. We ask that parents don't gather before 2.55pm if collecting their child by car or walking.

Primary 2 pupils should be collected from Mrs Meehan's external door at 1.55pm.

The Primary 1 day will end at 12.30pm up until Friday the 30^{th} September.

From Tuesday the 4th October Primary 1 pupils will finish at 1.55pm and exit via the external door in Mrs Meehan's room.

To help with the smooth exit of pupils who walk or travel home by car in the evening we will continue the following arrangement;

Surname A - L will exit via the pedestrian gate at 3.00pm

Surname M - W will exit via the main gate at 3.00pm.

Please keep entrance and the clearly marked bus area free until after both buses have departed.

Buses depart school at 2.55pm.

Dinner:

The daily cost of school dinner is £2.60 per day (£13.00 per week). We would ask that money for the week be brought in on Mondays.

Free School Meals:

Some children may be entitled to free meals. An application form may be obtained from the Education Authority, School Meals Department 1 Hospital Road, Omagh, Co Tyrone, BT79 OAW. Telephone (028 82 411411).

The EA submits a list of children receiving free school meals to us.

If your child's name is not on this list and you feel they should be I ask that you contact the EA immediately.

We as a school are working together with the Health Promotion Department to promote healthy eating habits and improve oral health in children.

Children taking lunch may bring <u>one</u> treat in their lunch box.

Only staff cars should enter the school car park.

Please do not park in the bus lay-by at

the front of the school.

Parking here presents a hazard for children

boarding buses and

prevents buses from pulling in.
