School Hours:

The teaching day begins at 9.05am and children should be

If your child's name is not on this list and you feel they should be I ask that you contact the EA immediately.

We as a school are working together with the Health Promotion Department to promote healthy eating habits and improve oral health in children. Children taking lunch may bring <u>one</u> treat in their lunch box.

Only staff cars should enter the school car park. Please do not park
in the bus lay-by at the front of the school.
