School Uniform:	It is important that each child comes to school neat and tidy. Child Protection:	The Designated teacher for Child Protection is Mrs Martina Meehan. The Deputy Designated Teacher is Mrs Anne Murray.		
Attendance:	The Department of Education is looking at attendance very closely at present. If a child's attendance falls below 85% we are asked to refer them to our Educational Welfare Officer. Pupils with full attendance each term will receive a school certificate. Pupils with full attendance for the whole school year will receive a certificate from the Education Authority. If your child is absent, please send a note or fill out the absence note in the homework diary.
